

**CITY OF EVERETT CITIZENS' COMMISSION  
ON SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS  
SALARY SCHEDULE FOR 2022 - 2023**

**The City of Everett Citizens' Commission on Salaries of Elected Officials pursuant to Section 2.8 of the City of Everett Charter hereby adopts the following salary schedule for elected officials:**

**1. Mayor:** The Mayor's salary for 2021 is \$16,246 per month through December 31, 2021.

Effective January 1, 2022, the Mayor's salary for 2022 will remain \$16,246 per month through December 31, 2022.

Effective January 1, 2023, the Mayor's salary for 2023 will remain \$16,246 per month through December 31, 2023.

**2. City Council Members:** The City Council members' salary for 2021 is \$2,511 per month through December 31, 2021.

Effective January 1, 2022, the City Council members' salary will remain \$2,511 per month through December 31, 2022.

Effective January 1, 2023, the City Council members' salary will remain \$2,511 per month through December 31, 2023.

**3. City Council President/Mayor Pro Tem:** The salary for the City Council member designated as the City Council President/Mayor Pro Tem shall be an additional thirty percent (30%) of his/her salary as a Council member.

**4. Municipal Court Judges:** In accordance with Everett Municipal Code 2.108.040 (C), the salary for a full-time Everett Municipal Court Judge shall be equal to that of a Washington State District Court Judge (currently \$190,120 per year) and shall automatically be adjusted at such times and with the same effective dates as any adjustment to the salary of Washington State District Court Judges.

**5. Benefits:** All benefits for the Mayor, City Council members, and Municipal Court Judges are provided for outside the scope of this schedule.
